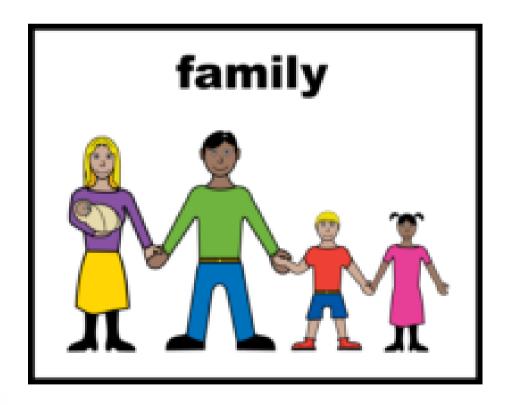

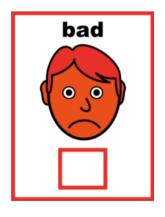

2.Work with schools to better support young people



3. Give better support with sleep and advice



4. Give regular updates for young people and their families about where they are on the waiting lists and appointments

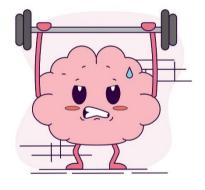


5. Give more support while waiting for a diagnosis of Autism and ADHD

In the last 5 years there has been an increase in demand for children and young people requesting an assessment for neurodiversity



Neurodiversity is another word for autism and ADHD and how our brains process information



This has increased waiting times



We are keen to work with young people to improve our services with the resources we have



This report is important to help us develop help and support



Families have said they do get support



But they do not always get the help they need



This report shows that there is still a lot of work to do to understand the support children and young people would find the most helpful



We must continue to develop our workforce across children and young people services



We must continue to work with everyone to improve the support we offer
